voluntarily apply to participate on a trip arranged by of ALJ, Inc. dba Adventure Life with knowledge that travel to foreign countries and/or remote areas visited by this trip involves numerous risks and dangers. I also understand that I am booking an adventure holiday and standards such as accommodations, transport, medical service and other factors will not be maintained or operated to standards common in the United States, or on a conventional holiday.

### RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF ALL RISKS

ALJ, Inc., its employees, shareholders, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, successors, agents, and assigns (collectively ALJ, Inc.) does not own or operate any entity which provides goods or services for your trip including, for example, lodging facilities, bus, plane, train, canoes, yacht or other transportation companies or devices, food service providers, equipment suppliers, etc. By utilizing the travel services of these independent suppliers, ALJ, Inc. is not liable for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any such person, or of any other third party. I understand the responsibility of ALJ, Inc. is strictly limited. As a US-based adventure travel company, ALJ, Inc. organizes, promotes, and sells tour programs consisting of, but not limited to, the travel services mentioned above, which ALJ, Inc. purchases or reserves from various suppliers in my behalf. I am aware, and I clearly understand, that the suppliers providing travel services for tour programs sold by ALJ, Inc. are independent contractors and are not agents or employees of ALJ, Inc. nor does ALJ, Inc. act as an agent for any supplier of travel services.

I acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate in the trip designated on this application (or a trip to which I may subsequently transfer). I am voluntarily participating in this trip with the knowledge of the numerous risks and dangers involved including but not limited to: physical exertion for which I am not prepared; forces of nature; transportation failures whether by plane, train, auto, boat, canoe, kayak, bicycle, ski, horseback or other animal, by foot, or by any other conveyance; consumption of alcoholic beverages; risks associated with food or impure water; civil unrest; terrorism; criminal activity; dangers associated with wild or other animals; breakdown or faulty maintenance of equipment; insufficient instruction or assistance; high altitude; accident or illness without access to means of rapid evacuation or availability of medical supplies or services; the adequacy of medical attention once provided; and stolen, lost, or misplaced luggage or property. I understand that ALJ, Inc. will have no liability regarding the adequacy of any evacuation plan, medical care, equipment or supplies that may be provided. I acknowledge that the enjoyment of travel is derived in part from the inherent risks incurred by travel and activity beyond the accepted safety of life at home or work and that these inherent risks contribute to such enjoyment. **I HEREBY AGREE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MY OWN WELFARE AND ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS OF DELAY, UNANTICIPATED EVENTS, INCONVENIENCE, ILLNESS, INJURY, LOSS, EMOTIONAL TRAUMA OR DEATH.** I acknowledge that the cost of all ALJ, Inc. trips are based upon trip participants executing this Release of Liability, Assumption of All Risk, and Arbitration Agreement. Therefore, as lawful consideration for being permitted to participate on such trip(s), **I HEREBY RELEASE AND DISCHARGE FOREVER ALJ, INC. FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL LIABILITY ARISING FROM MY PARTICIPATION IN THE TRIP.** I agree that this release shall be legally binding upon me personally, all members of my family and all minors traveling with me, my and their heirs, successors, assigns, and legal representatives, it being my intention fully to assume all the risks associated with this trip and to release ALJ, Inc. from any and all liabilities to the maximum extent permitted by law.

### BINDING ARBITRATION

I accept that this contract was entered into and performed in the city of Missoula, in the State of Montana. In the unlikely event of any dispute concerning, relating, or referring to this contract, the catalog, or any other literature concerning my trip, or the trip itself, I agree to the following conditions: 1) the dispute shall be resolved exclusively by binding arbitration in Missoula, Montana according to the then existing rules of the American Arbitration Association; 2) the maximum amount of recovery to which I will be entitled from ALJ, Inc. under any and all circumstances shall not exceed the amount of it's fee for professional services, less actual expenses incurred in arranging my travel. Such proceedings will be governed by substantive Montana law. Should any part of this contract be found invalid or not enforceable by a court of law, then the remaining portion shall continue to be valid and in force.

### KNOWING AND VOLUNTARY EXECUTION

My signature below certifies that I have carefully read and fully understand the contents of this agreement including the Terms and Conditions, especially those regarding cancellation and refund policies, limitation of liability, and responsibility borne by trip participants. On the advance of a deposit to ALJ, Inc., the depositor, his or her family and heirs agree to be bound by the above Liability Release and Terms and Conditions.

# Terms and Conditions

## 1. CONTRACT with ALJ, INC. DBA ADVENTURE LIFE

Anyone wanting to make a booking must complete the Registration Form and sign the Terms and Conditions and Liability Release. The person(s) included on the registration form are referred to as the "client" below. All clients will be bound by the conditions that follow. All bookings are made with ALJ, Inc. DBA Adventure Life, which sells the tours described in the brochure and website. No person has any authority on Adventure Life's behalf to vary these booking conditions. The service to be provided is the tour(s) referred to in Adventure Life brochure, website and discussed with it's agents.

## 2. PAYMENT and ACCEPTANCE of BOOKING

The registration forms must be completed and signed by all those who wish to travel. The form should then be returned to Adventure Life with a non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person, per trip. Note that some tours may require additional deposit. If a booking is made 10 weeks or less before the departure date then the full amount is due at the time of booking. Acceptance of the client's booking must be confirmed in writing and it is only at this stage that a contract comes into existence. The balance of the tour cost is due 10 weeks before the departure date. Payment may be made in the form of check, money order, bank transfer or credit card. Note that a convenience fee of 3% is assessed to all card-not-present final payments. If this balance is not paid 10 weeks before departure, Adventure Life reserves the right to treat the client's booking as cancelled by the client and is subject to the cancellation fees below.

## 3. CANCELLATIONS and REFUNDS

A cancellation by the client must be made in writing. The date that Adventure Life receives the letter determines the cancellation charge applicable. Cancellation fees are as follows:

Please note that some tours and cruises apply a different cancellation schedule as indicated on invoice. In this case, this cancellation policy supersedes the information above. The client is strongly advised to purchase cancellation insurance at the time of making the booking, as this will cover cancellation charges in certain circumstances. Payments due at the time of cancellation remain the responsibility of the client.

## 4. CANCELLATION by ADVENTURE LIFE

Adventure Life reserves the right to cancel a tour for any reason. It will not cancel a tour less than 8 weeks before departure except in the case of force majeure, consolidation, or the client's failure to pay the final balance. If a tour is cancelled due to consolidation or force majeure the client may choose a full refund of all payments made or an alternative tour offered by Adventure Life. If the alternative tour chosen by the client is of lesser or greater value than the tour originally booked then the client will be entitled to a refund of the price difference or be required to pay the price difference, however the case may be. Force majeure is an unusual or unforeseen circumstance outside the company's control. Consolidation refers to the fact that each tour is dependent upon a minimum number of persons participating.

## 5. UNUSED SERVICES

No partial refunds are possible for unused services including hotel rooms, air or land transport, trekking days, or other sightseeing excursions.

## 6. PRICES, SURCHARGES & BROCHURE VALIDITY

As we publish our prices more than a year in advance, we may occasionally be faced with significant cost increases due to factors over which we have no control. As such we reserve the right to impose surcharges or price increases due to unfavorable exchange rates, increases in air fares or other transport costs, taxes, or if government action should require us to do so. If any surcharge results in an increase of more than 10% of the tour cost excluding insurance premiums the client may cancel the booking within 14 days of notification of the surcharge and obtain a full refund. ## 8. SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

Trip prices are based on double or shared occupancy in hotels, lodges, yachts, tents, etc. Single accommodations can often be arranged for an extra cost but may be limited on some trips according to the availability. If you are traveling alone & wish to share with another traveler, the first willing-to-share, same gender roommate will be assigned. Should no one be available at the time you register, the Single Supplement is payable and you will be invoiced accordingly. If a roommate is found prior to departure, this fee will be refunded. Some yachts/cruises do not require a single supplement as long as you are willing-to-share, even if a roommate cannot be found.

## 9. MEDICAL FITNESS and AGE

Good physical and mental health is essential for the enjoyment of these trips. By forwarding the deposit, the client certifies that he/she does not have any physical or other conditions that would create a hazard for himself/herself or other travelers. Any client over the age of 65 or with preexisting medical conditions must complete a medical certificate. If the medical form cannot be completed for any reason and has not been returned to the client by the final payment date specified above, then Adventure Life reserves the right to treat the booking as cancelled by the client. Once a trip has been confirmed, medical conditions will not be considered as exceptions to the cancellation policy.

## 10. FLEXIBILITY

The itinerary as stated for each tour must be taken only as an indication of what each group may accomplish and not a contractual obligation. The client acknowledges that the nature of this type of travel requires significant flexibility and should allow for changes. The client understands that the amenities, type of transport, route, schedule, and itinerary may change without prior notice due to local circumstances or events, which may include mechanical breakdown, flight cancellations, illness, strikes, political disputes, weather, border crossing problems & other unforeseeable factors.

## 12. CHANGES by ADVENTURE LIFE

While Adventure Life does its best to operate all tours as advertised, reasonable changes in itinerary may be made where considered necessary. Adventure Life also reserves the right to change any of the services and facilities described in the tour descriptions before a booking is made. If such a change is made, the client will be told at the time of booking. If Adventure Life makes a major change, the company will inform the client as soon as possible if there is time before departure. A major change is defined as a change affecting one day in five of the itinerary. If the major change is due to force majeure or unforeseen circumstance no refund or compensation is payable.

## 13. CHANGES by the CLIENT

The client may only make a change to a booking at least 70 days before departure. Any additional costs will be charged. Note that scheduled airlines may impose 100% cancellation charges. A transfer from one tour to another can only be made at least 70 days before the departure date of the first booked tour. If Adventure Life accepts such a request, then the company reserves the right to charge an administration fee of 10% of the value of the first booked tour. A request to transfer received less than 70 days before departure will not be accepted. In this case the client must cancel the booking and then rebook on another tour.

## 15. AUTHORITY on TOUR

The client must at all times comply with the laws, customs, foreign exchange and drug regulations of the countries visited. At all times the decision of the local guide or local supplier is final on all matters that may threaten the safety or interfere with the well being of the group or individual travelers. Should the client fail to comply with the above, or should the client interfere with the well being of the group, then the local guide or local supplier may order the client to leave the tour without recourse to any refund.

## 16. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

The client must obtain and have possession of a valid passport and all visas, permits, and vaccination certificates, required for the entire tour. The client accepts responsibility for obtaining these documents and any other necessary documents. Information or advice given by Adventure Life on visas, vaccinations, climate, clothing, baggage, special equipment, etc. is given in good faith but without responsibility on the part of Adventure Life.

## 17. CLAIMS and COMPLAINTS

If a client has a complaint against Adventure Life, the client must first inform the local guide/supplier while on the tour in order that the guide/supplier can attempt to rectify the matter. Any further complaint must be put in writing to the company within 30 days of the end of the tour.

## 18. INSURANCE

It is the client's responsibility to obtain personal travel insurance. The client is willing to accept full responsibility for insurance up to limits that the client may require. This insurance must cover personal accident, medical expenses, air ambulance, loss of effects, repatriation costs and all other expenses which might arise as a result of loss, damage, injury, delay or inconvenience occurring to the client. It is compulsory that all clients have personal travel related medical insurance. When the client has taken travel insurance through Adventure Life, the client acknowledges that he or she is satisfied with the levels of insurance arranged by us. If he or she does not take such insurance through Adventure Life, the client understands that the price of the tour does not include any insurance. When obtaining travel insurance from a source other than Adventure Life, the client must make certain that the insurer is aware of the type of travel the client will be undertaking.

## 19. AIRLINES

Our responsibility in respect of air travel is limited by the airline's conditions of carriage. Adventure Life is not able to specify the type of aircraft to be used by any airline. In addition, Adventure Life is not responsible for losses due to cancelled flights or seats or changed flight itineraries. The client cannot cancel the contract without penalty due to a change of airline, aircraft type or destination. Similarly, the contents of our catalog or website do not commit the airlines mentioned here.
